Billy Graham Preached in a Nashville Crusade in June, 2000

Yet the date and place mean little. Graham preached the same message in June, 2000, that he presented the last time he was in Nashville, and the time before that-the same message as in every other city. Billy Graham has been consistent. We knew what to expect. We knew there would be many "decisions for Christ." We knew that men and women would be counseled to "pray the Sinner's Prayer." We also knew that the command to "be baptized...for the remission of sins" (Acts 2:38) would not be heard!

#### Graham Crusade Counselors

Everyone who applied to be a counselor signed an application form stating that he understood that "Only Crusade counseling materials are to be used." The official counseling materials prescribed that the one being counseled was to "ask Him to take away my sin...Then I'll be a part of God's family." "You cross the bridge into God's family when you prayerfully ask Jesus to come into your life."

This was all carefully planned. It has always worked effectively. It has achieved the purposes of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association. As expected, many evangelical Protesant churches supported the Crusade. Billy Graham was preaching their message.

The Shelly Connection

But in this Crusade there was somenting new--an inexplicable phenomenon – an utterly unaccountable occurrence: **Rubel Shelly** joined the Billy Graham Crusade!

Who is Rubel Shelly? Shelly preaches for the Woodmont Hills Family of God in Nashville. When he began his association with this church in 1978, it was called the Ashwood Church of Christ.

Additional Background: Shelly became a Christian more than forty vears ago. He heard the gospel, believed, repented, confessed his faith in Jesus as the Son of God, and was baptized into Christ for the forgiveness of his sins. On that day, the Lord added Rubel to His church (Acts 2:47).

Like many others in the Woodmont Hills Family of God, Shelly was blessed as a young person with the advantage of being taught the pure gospel of Jesus Christ. In sermons, in Sunday School classes, at home, over and over, repeatedly, the plan of salvation was impressed at every opportunity-that every accountable person must...

- 1. **Hear** the gospel (Romans 10:17)
- 2. Believe in Jesus (Mark 16:16)
- 3. **Repent** of sins (Luke 24:47)
- 4. Confess faith in Jesus as the Son of God

more than ten years, brother Bland has taught the School's courses in personal evangelism and world evangelism. He has, additionally, during this time, headed up the very successful campaigns of the School. Bland is also a great example of carrying the pure gospel to foreign lands. He has made seventeen trips to Russia, helping pioneer the work in Murmansk and co-ordinating the work with Murmansk Bible College, an extension of the MSOP.

Brother Billy directs the Far East/World Evangelism work (formerly headed up by brother Ira Y. Rice, Jr.), which is under the sponsorship of the splendid Coldwater Church of Christ, Coldwater, MS; and edits the Far East/World Evangelism Newsletter. He has made four evangelistic trips to Singapore, Malaysia, Philippines, India, Thailand, et al., and is involved with works in these countries. He further serves as Chairman of the Board of Four Seas College in Singapore; the writer is privileged to serve as Co-Chairman of the College's Board of Trustees.

Most of the faculty members of the Memphis School of Preaching have made evangelistic trips both in the United States and in many foreign countries. The emphasis of the School is the preaching of the unadulterated Word througout the world; the students benefit greatly from that Biblical mandate. We congratulate Billy Bland upon receiving this deserved recognition.

5. Be baptized for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38)

6. Live the Christian Life (2 Peter 1:10)

Yet, Shelly was committed to using only the prescribed counseling materials. These said nothing about obedience in baptism being necessary for salvation! How could Rubel Shelly, in good conscience, take part in a crusade where Jesus' command: "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved" (Mark 16:16) was not respected?

What startling insensitivity toward those precious souls who, in sincerity, responded during the Crusade-only to be misled by the counselors into thinking they could be saved by praying the "Sinner's Prayer." They did not learn at the Crusade that they were to be "baptized into Christ" (Galatians 3:27). They were not told to "...be

#### baptized and wash away thy sins..." (Acts 22:16).

In the past, some have attempted to justify various highly questionable religious practices by saying that those things were "not salvation issues." For example, those who follow Shelly's lead said this about taking part in interfaith gatherings where musical instruments were used. But this time, what is involved is the very gospel plan of salvation itself. This is the ultimate salvation issue!

Postscript: Many people who now attend Rubel's church have had a background in the church of Christ. These people, too, have some accountability. Shelly could not lead if his elders and other members did not so willingly follow.

#### Questions Often Asked About Rubel Shelly

When did he fall away? What caused his apostasy? What makes him delight in evoking laughter from audiences of non-members as he makes fun of the church of Christ?

Does anyone have the answers? Does Rubel Shelly himself really know and understand what has happened to him?

Shelly has been the co-editor of a magazine called Wineskins. From the very first, Shelly's magazine was an example of irresponsible journalism. The first issue carried an article called "David Lipscomb's Middle Way." Lipscomb died in 1917 after serving fifty years as editor of the Gospel Advocate. Quotations, falsely attributed to Lipscomb, purported to show that Lipscomb believed salvation comes before and without baptism. Lipscomb devoted his life to teaching just the opposite.

That magazine should have made its first issue its last issue. Lying about the dead may be no worse than telling lies about the living. But the living, at least, can respond. The November, 1992, Wineskins was the most notorious of all. That was the one that included an article called 'Christmas at Matthew's House." The article did not simply **deny** the virgin birth of Jesus. It reveled in speaking of the scandal surrounding Mary, calling her "another sexually questionable woman."

This is not to say that Rubel Shelly does not believe in the virgin birth. He does believe. But that is what makes his publication of such disgusting fiction even more reprehensible.

Shelly's influence has been far-reaching. No one in the history of Nashville – at least not since Jesse B. Ferguson 150 years ago – has been so divisive and so destructive to the church of Christ as Rubel Shelly. By Garland Elkins and James McGill



NEW TV PROGRAM, A BIBLE ANSWER, BEGINS! Mike McDaniel

n May 31, 2004, a new television program began to air in West Tennessee and the Missouri Bootheel. A work of the Phillips Street Church of Christ in Dyersburg, Tennessee, the program is called A Bible Answer. It has a question and answer format.

Mike McDaniel, evangelist with the Central Church of Christ in Caruthersville, Missouri, and a 1985 MSOP graduate, is serving as the Moderator. Dustin Forthun, preacher for the Phillips Street Church of Christ, and a 1999 MSOP graduate, serves as Secretary/Treasurer. Rick Lawson, who preaches for the Gardner Church of Christ, and is a 1999 MSOP graduate, serves as Tract Coordinator. The program is under the oversight of the good elders at Phillips Street.

When Searching The Scriptures ceased to air at the end of 2003, after having being on various local stations since the mid-1970's, many people hoped that something might be done to fill in the gap. Many liked the question and answer format (which utilizes three different area gospel preachers each month to answer questions sent in by viewers) because it had proven to be successful.
